Course Description

The main purpose of this course is to develop students' ability and accuracy in using professional English language by learning effective ways of communication skills. The course is constructed to adopt practical methods in teaching various language skills including reading, writing, and speaking. 5. To develop students' skills of building and developing relationships and personal and professional networks.
6. To enable students to form grammatical sentences and questions correctly.

In addition, students have to attend and complete a free course on Coursera which is related to the topics of the course.
